DEMOLITION PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with EPA guidance
Demolition is a "Construction Activity"

The NPDES Stormwater Program regulates construction activities that meet both of the following criteria:

- (1) Contributes stormwater discharges to surface waters of the state or into a municipal separate storm sewer system. (MS4)
- (2) Disturbs one or more acres of land. Less than one acre is included if the activity is part of a larger common plan of development or sale that will meet or exceed the one acre threshold. (i.e. a subdivision or linear road projects that will ultimately exceed one acre of disturbance)

If your project applies to the above criteria, you must submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Department of Environmental Protection and be issued a Generic Permit for Stormwater Discharge from large and small construction activities.
